The Sustainable Workplace Alliance is a not-for-profit 501 (c) (3) organization dedicated to proving a safer workplace for the U.S. workforce. We accomplish this mission by providing training and technical support to employers and employees across the nation with emphasis on under-served communities.

The Sustainable Workplace Alliance has been awarded a worker training grant from the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIEHS) which provides environmental related training and job placement services to students in under served communities. With this training grant, SWA has been allowed to conduct 3 job training classes per grant year. Our focus has been Brevard County, FL and just announced, the San Juan area of Puerto Rico.

Our average student before entering the program earns about \$11,000 per year, but upon completion of the no-cost program, our graduates average a pay rate of \$34,000 per year and includes benefits and a true career path. This program has experienced incredible success and we're excited to continue to offer this training and job placement program.
